What an amazing year. Every **radiate** activity has grown and lots of targets have been achieved and surpassed.

Highlights for me were the **Fun Day** which reached out into our community and, of course, the **Holiday Club** which not only attracted over 100 young people but also involved more than 40 Volunteers. It is amazing to see young people accepting, as equals, those of us who are somewhat mature.

During the year Cara was deservedly awarded a **National Youth Worker of the Year Award** and seven of our Volunteers successfully completed **Street Work Training**. This heralds the start of a new activity reaching out to the Young People of Cathcart and inviting them to join in with our activities.

We will soon have another member of staff to help with this exciting new provision and we hope to set up a facility which will become a **local, after school, drop-in Centre**.

All of what has been achieved so far and what we intend to develop has been underpinned by the financial support from the three Churches, the Parish Development Fund, a number of Charities and of course Parents and Friends. Please consider becoming a **Friend of Radiate**. I want a *lot* of people to make a *small* commitment (say £5 per month).

TREASURER'S REPORT



The financial year to the end of November 2011 has been a good one, with the healthy year end balance of £11,697 largely earmarked for the future developments documented elsewhere. Grateful thanks are particularly due to those individuals in all three congregations (and beyond) who have supported CYMP with one-off and ongoing gifts, most with the added bonus of Gift Aid.

The church partners continue to contribute the core funding for the partnership, reflecting the invaluable base of prayer, goodwill and willing volunteer hours which no annual accounts can put a value on.

Grant awards from the Church of Scotland Parish Development Fund (PDF), the Baird Trust, the Souter Charitable Trust, and the James Wood Bequest Fund have also bolstered our finances. The last three were one-off grants but the PDF has shown its support for the last 3 years, and has recently confirmed a further 2 years' funding which is much appreciated. A sub-group of trustees takes time throughout the year to research and apply for grant support from a wide range of bodies.

Comparison of 2011 figures with the previous year shows some positive trends. (Please note that the Cathcart Trinity contribution for 2010 actually totalled £7,500, of which £5,000 was paid early and therefore shown in the 2009 accounts).

- Donation and fund-raising income increased by about £7,300, with approximately £2,000 of this used to fund CYMP young people on summer mission assignments in Thailand and Hungary.
- In line with increased funding, significant increases in expenditure items such as programme expenses and training reflect the commitment of Cara and the CYMP board to develop and invest in youth ministry facilities and personnel.
- Salary cost increases reflect some accounting adjustments for prior years relating to the payroll services shared with Cathcart Trinity which have no employee impact.
